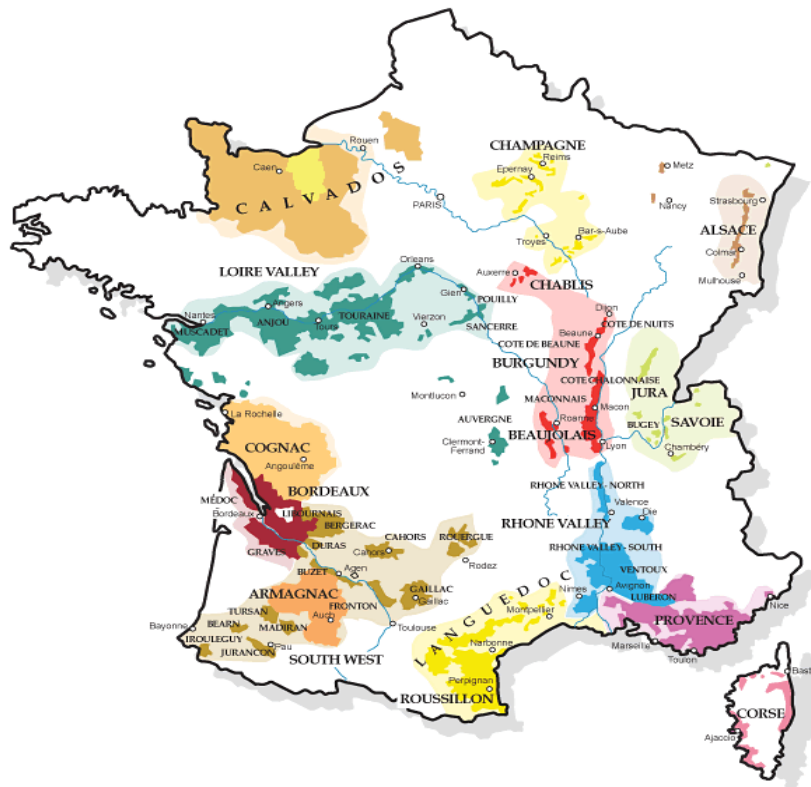




## FF-241 Transport of Wine - France (2)

France produces 7-8 billion bottles of wine per annum with its wine making industry dating back to the 6<sup>th</sup> Century. A decline in domestic consumption means an increased requirement for exports, in competition with the wines produced in the New World.

### Export Flights

1. Load “Blanquette de Limoux” at Carcassonne, LFMK and fly to London Heathrow, EGLL. 508 nm.
2. Load “Château Chalon” at Vias, LFMU. Fly to Frankfurt, EDDF. 455 nm.
3. Load “ Pineau des Charentes” at Cognac. LFGA. Fly to Lisbon, LPPT. 908 nm.
4. Load “Côtes de Côteaux d’Aix” at Nice, LFMN. Fly to Dublin, EIDW. 791 nm.
