



MF-187 Operation Deference - Libya



An escalation of anti-government unrest in Libya required the evacuation of “Non Essential Personnel” (NEP) from the gas and oil industries. RAF aircraft from 30 Sqdn were deployed from RAF Brize Norton and evacuated NEP, initially, to Malta.

Aircraft C130 (or any appropriate aircraft)

Deployment

1. Depart RAF Brize Norton, EGVN. Fly to Luqa Int, LMML. 1176 nm.

Evacuation Flights

2. Depart Luqa, LMML. Land at Benina- Benghazi, HLLB. Load NEP and return to Malta. 730nm.
3. Depart Luqa, LMML. Land at Al Khuwymat, HLOP. Load NEP and return to Malta. 1260 nm.

4. Depart Luqa, LMML. Land at Marsa-Brega, HLMB. Load NEP and return to Malta. 830 nm.

Return from deployment.

5. Fly from Luqa, LMML to RAF Brize Norton, EGVN. 1176 nm.
