



MF-191 Operation Juniper Micron - Mali (OJM)



In February 2013, US Africa Command (AFRICOM) was responsible for OJM. At the request of the French Government, OJM was tasked with transporting French troops and supplies to Mali and the provision of airborne refuelling capabilities. By March 2013, USAF Air Lift Wings had transported 5.3 million tonnes to Mali and USAF tankers had flown 750 sorties.
