



MF-198 Red Flag - 2017 (2)



Red Flag is an annual, advanced aerial-combat training exercise hosted by Nellis AFB. Participants include the USAF, USMC, and numerous NATO air forces. The exercise uses the Nevada Test & Training Range north west of Las Vegas covering 60x100 nm. This mission involves the deployment of participant aircraft from home bases.

Aircraft F-35, KC-135, B-1B (Or any appropriate aircraft)

1. F35 aircraft from 388th FW. Luke AFB, KLUF, to Nellis AFB, KLSV. 208 nm.



2. B1 aircraft from 28th Bomb Wing at Ellsworth AFB, KRCA, to Nellis AFB. 723nm.



3. KC135 aircraft from 927th ARW at MacDill AFB, KMCF, to Nellis AFB. 1719 nm.
