



## MF-199 Oil Burner 98 - Rapid City South Dakota

US military navigation and bombing training routes. "Oil Burner Flights" are dedicated aerial corridors in which aircraft may operate below 10,000 ft at speeds above the mandatory 250Kt limit. OB-98 is located in South Dakota.
