**Flights**

1. Embark troops from 2<sup>nd</sup> Armoured Infantry Battalion-Jydske Dragonregimentet at Vojens Skrydstrup AB, EKSP. Transport troops to Larnaca, LCLK. 1636 nm.
2. Embark troops from 1<sup>st</sup> Armoured Infantry Battalion Gardehusarregimentet at Ronne Borholm, EKRN. Fly to Lanarca. LCLK. 1493 nm.
3. Return Hungarian troops from Istvan Boeskar Infantry Brigade from Lanarca. LCLK to Ferihegy Budapest, LHBP. 990 nm.
