



**MF-201 UN "MONUSCO" - Democratic Republic of Congo**



The UN Stabilisation Mission in the DR Congo (MONUSCO) is a peace-keeping mission established by UN Security Council Resolutions in 1999 and 2000. The aim being to monitor the peace process after the Second Congo Civil War.

The UN force of around 20,000 personnel, drawn from 60 countries, has struggled to stem civil violence in a conflict involving dozens of armed groups and complicated by national and ethnic rivalries.



This mission involves the deployment of troops from Senegal and rotation of current Nigerian peace-keepers.

3. Return Nigerian Peace-Keepers from 1<sup>st</sup> Infantry Division from Dakar, GOOY to Kaduna, DNKA. 1470 nm.
