



**MF-211 Operation Sangaris - Central African Republic (CAR) Phase 3**

Operation Sangaris was a French intervention in the CAR in 2013. In 2012 the President, Francois Bozizé, requested international aid to suppress the Séléka - an anti Government, Muslim rebel group. The UN set up an International Support Mission to the CAR (MISCA) .

France, UK and Belgium responded with troops and aircraft. This mission is Phase 3 of 3 deployments of troops and equipment to the CAR. Some historical facts have been changed to suit FS.

1. A340 Escadron 3/60 Load troops from 1<sup>st</sup> Parachutistes Chasseur at Caritat Orange AB, LFMO. Depart Orange. Land at Algiers, DAAG. 426 nm.
2. Depart Algiers, DAAG. Land at Niamey, DRRN. 1394 nm.
3. Depart Niamey. Land at M'poko Bangui, FEFF. 1110 nm.
4. A340 of Escadron 3/60 "Estoril". Load troops from 1<sup>st</sup> Parachutistes Hussar at Leon M'ba Libreville, FOOL. Transport troops to Bangui, FEFF. 595 nm.
