



MVF-115 Cairo - Baghdad Airmail 1921



The airmail route was established by the Royal Air Force in 1921. The aim being to create an air link between Egypt and Mesopotamia (Iraq). Imperial Airways took over the route in 1927 and extended it to Basra.
