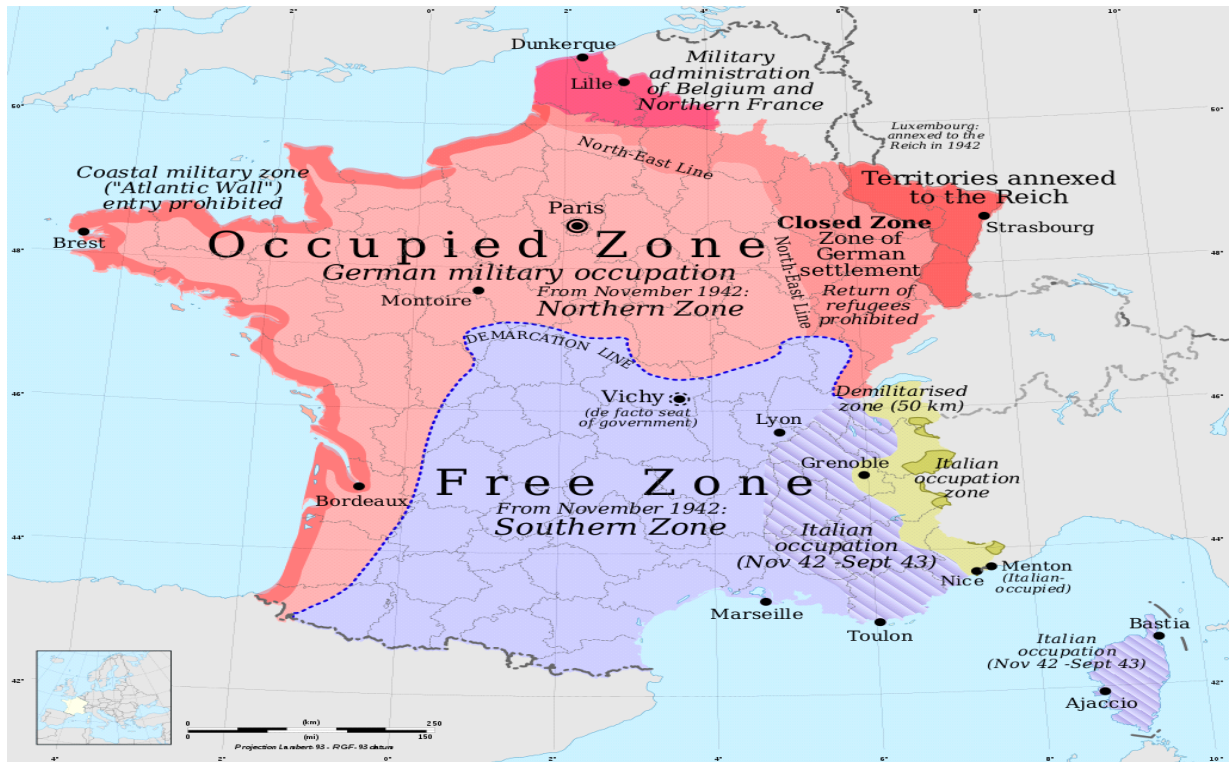




MVF-128 Armée de l'air de Vichy - WW2



After the defeat of France in WW2, in 1940, the Vichy Government was formed by the French to collaborate with the Germans and was situated in southern France. The Armée de l'air de Vichy was the aerial branch of that government.

In retaliation, after British attacks at Oran and Dakar (French West Africa), the Vichy Air Force carried out bombing raids on Gibraltar.



Aircraft: Douglas DB7-B3 "Havoc" (Or any appropriate aircraft)

Bombing Attacks.

1. Depart Es Senia-Oran, DAOO. Simulated bombing of British base at Gibraltar, LXGB. Return to Oran. 464 nm.
2. Depart Tafaraoui, DAOL. Simulated bombing of British base at Gibraltar, LXGB. Return to Tafaroui. 474 nm.
3. Depart Fes-Sefrou, GMFU. Simulated bombing of British base at Gibraltar, LXGB. Return to Fes. 260 nm.
4. Depart Sale- Rabat GMME. Simulated bombing of British base at Gibraltar, LXGB. Return Rabat. 288 nm.
