



PTFF-23 – “Federal Express”

Federal Express (FedEx) is a cargo airline with a “superhub” at Memphis, TN. It is the world’s largest airline in terms of freight tonnes flown and the 4th largest in terms of fleet size, with 660 aircraft serving 375 destinations. It is contracted to the United Postal Service for air mail deliveries.

Suggested Aircraft:

Long Haul aircraft A300-600, A310, B757-200, B767-300F, MD-10, MD-11
Feeder aircraft ATR42, ATR72-200, Cessna 208B

Flight Schedule:

Long Haul – Night Flights

1. Fly from Super Hub Memphis Intl (KMEM) to Regional Hub at Dallas-Fort Worth (KFDW) – 378nm.
2. Fly from International Hub Indianapolis Intl (KIND) to Regional Hub at Miami Intl (KMIA) – 888nm.
3. Fly from Regional Hub Newark (KEWR) to Bangor (KBGR) – 342nm.

Feeder Flights

4. Fly from Philadelphia Intl (KPHL) to Reading Regional (KRDG), on to Westchester Co (KHPN), on to Kennedy Intl, NY (KJFK) and end flight at Newark (KEWR) – 200nm.
5. Fly from St Lucie Co Intl (KFPR) to Palm Beach (KPBI), on to Ft Lauderdale (KFXE) and end flight at Miami Intl (KMIA) – 105nm.
