



PTFF-24 - "Pan Am Airmail"

Historically, the US Government strongly supported an air mail service between North and South America and in March 1928 Congress passed the first Foreign Airmail Act. Pan Am was awarded the contract and landing rights for flights to Cuba, Puerto Rico, Bahamas, Mexico and Chile.

Suggested Aircraft:

Sikorsky Flying Boats S-38, S-40 and S-42
Any appropriate amphibious aircraft.

Flight Schedule:

1. Fly from Chalk's Key West (61FD) to Fernando Luis Ribas Dominicci, San Juan, PR (TJIG) - 950nm.
2. Fly from Chalk's Key West (61FD) to Nassau Intl, Bahamas (MYNN). Land on lake east of the airfield - 240nm.
3. Fly from Chalk's Key West (61FD) to Lic Benito Juarez Intl, Mexico City (MMMX). Land on lake east of RWY 23L threshold - 1006nm.

Total flight distance 2,196nm.
