

## PTFF-49 - US Contract Airmail Flights (3)

---

The Airmail Act of 1925 (Kelly Act) authorized the US Postmaster General, to award contracts for the delivery of US air mail to commercial carriers. Contract airmail routes became known as "CAM's."

CAM 33 was awarded to Inter-Island Airways  
CAM 34 was awarded to Pennsylvania Central Airlines  
CAM 35 was awarded to Wyoming Air Services

2. Kahului to Hilo (PHTO) – 105nm.
3. Hilo to Lihue (PHLI) – 276nm.

4. Washington-Dulles (KIAD) to Harrisburg (KMDT) – 82nm.
5. Harrisburg to Buffalo-Niagara (KBUF) – 187nm.

- **CAM 35 – Boeing B247**

6. Great Falls Intl (KGTF) to Denver (KDEN) – 541nm.
7. Denver to Huron Regl (KHON) – 395nm.
8. Huron to Cheyenne (KCYS) – 349nm.
