## PTFF-78 – “Tajik Air”

Tajikistan Airlines commenced operations as early as 1924. The first aircraft appeared in the capital Dushanbe, 2 years before the first automobile and 5 years before the railways. Tajik Air is the 6<sup>th</sup> oldest airline in the world. It provides essential cargo flights between the capital and remote highland settlements.

Antonov AN-24 (comparable a/c DHC-6 or Do228) Boeing B737

### **Flight Schedule:**

1. Dushanbe (UTDD) – Khorog (FS9 – UTØD/FSX - UT1C) - Murgab (FS9 – TJØE/FSX - UT44) –Dushanbe (UTDD) - 514nm.
2. Khudzhand (UTDL) – Isfara (FS9 – UTØA/FSX - UT1A) – Fergana (FS9 – UTØT/FSX - UT1S) – Kokland SE (UTØJ) – Dushanbe (UTDD) - 278nm.

3. Termez (UTST) – Sariasaya (FS9 – UTØK/FSX - UT72) – Gissar (FS9 – TJØF/FSX - UT45) – Termez (UTST) - 208nm.
