



**FF-274 Aspen Medical - Sierra Leone**



Aspen Medical, formed in 2003, is a global provider of health services. In 2014, after the Ebola Virus outbreak in West Africa, Aspen Medical managed the Australian Government's response. This involved the setting up of remote treatment centers in Sierra Leone and a temporary hospital in Freetown.

**Aircraft:** Cessna Citation 550 (Or any appropriate aircraft)

**Flights** Transport of Ebola victims

1. Depart Lungi-Freetown GFL. Collect patient at BO, GFBO. Return to Freetown. 190 nm.
2. Transport patient from Kenema, GFKE to Freetown. 129 nm.

3. Depart Freetown, collect patient at Bonthe, GFBN. Return to Freetown. 154 nm.

4. Transport patient from Kabala, GFKB to Freetown. 117 nm.

**NOTAMS:**

Total 590 nm.

Four flights for ribbon credit. Pilots should complete all flights in numerical order before flying further missions.
