In March 1966 the French President Charles de Gaulle announced that France would withdraw from NATO. The US was informed that it must withdraw all US forces from France by April 1967. This action required several USAF aircraft to be deployed to the UK. (CMCO Note: Some locations are not available in FS requiring replacement airfields).
